He is a serial entrepreneur with more than 30 patents registered under his name, including a number of drugs being developed by Immuron and other international pharmaceutical companies. He has significant biotech industry experience as a founder of several start-up companies.

Patents include:

- Novel processes implementing selective immune downregulation (SIDR): Oral tolerance towards adenoviral vectors for long term gene expression using recombinant adenoviral vectors;
- Immunoregulation towards viral and tumor associated antigens; and
- The use of the non-invasive breath testing for follow-up of patients with liver and gastrointestinal disorders.

Professor Ilan will discuss Israel's unique ability and success in capturing intellectual property (IP), and transforming an idea into a commercialised product, based on the Hadasit case study.
