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Every day, the people of Jerusalem face formidable social and economic challenges, creating an ever-increasing demand for public mental health services for young children, adolescents and their families. Hadassah Hospital, through the Herman Dana Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and the Jerusalem Crisis Intervention Center (JCIC), provides an immediate response to the urgent needs of children in distress.

The Child and Adolescent Post Trauma clinic at Hadassah Hospital Mt. Scopus, with Outpatient Services and the JCIC at Ethiopia Street, play a significant role in improving the lives and well-being of the children and adolescents of Jerusalem - the poorest city in Israel - many of whom are from immigrant families.

Hadassah is committed to improving public health outcomes in Jerusalem, helping the disproportionately high percentage of psychologically challenged children before they require hospitalization.

Since 2007, Hadassah Hospital's trauma and early crisis intervention clinics have treated 1300 young patients in need.



The Ethiopia Street clinic, housed in a beautiful period mansion in the heart of downtown Jerusalem.

With 40% of Jerusalem's residents under 14, poverty, social and political pressures in this city of 800,000 result in significantly higher rates of child and adolescent stress than any other major city in Israel.

In 2006 Hadassah Australia "adopted" Hadassah Hospital's child and adolescent psychological day care and outpatient clinics in Jerusalem, including the Early Crisis Intervention Center at Ethiopia Street. Since then we have raised significant sums of money to cover the costs of the professional teams dealing with children in need.
